



## **Part-time Therapist**

**General Statement of Duties:** Responsible for the overall clinical needs of clients. Provide individual, group and family counseling.

### **Primary Duties:**

- Provide therapeutic services to children, adolescents, and adults (individual, group and family therapy).
- Maintain timely and accurate records of counseling/ therapy sessions, Service Assessments, Treatment Plans (Review every 90 days and make appropriate changes), and Discharge Summaries.
- Conduct any assessments as needed/required.
- Communicate with supervisors/staff regularly regarding the needs of the clients and their integration into other services.
- Attend trainings/meetings.
- Assist/train staff in crisis management.
- Provide on-call consultation to assist in resolution of client issues.
- Consult with collateral services (Social Services, parents, school personnel, probation office and others) who may have knowledge of client history/needs.
- Make collateral contacts for clients and work with staff/parents/guardians/collateral contacts on aftercare plan.
- Any other duties as assigned.

### **Job Knowledge:**

- Working knowledge of child development, effects of trauma on children, and dynamics of child abuse, domestic violence and family dynamics.
- Effective communication and problem solving skills.
- Familiarity with community services and social services delivery system.
- Working knowledge of the DSM-V.
- Crisis management skills required.

### **Qualifications:**

Licensure in NM (LMSW, LPCC, LPC, LISW, LMFT, LMAT, RN,CNS or psychologist/psychiatrist).
