

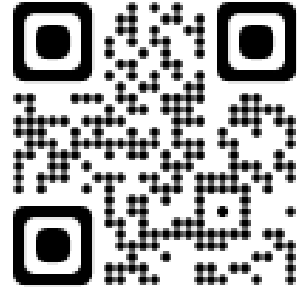

What does a CASA volunteer do?

Help Change a Child's Story through **Learning** about the child and their family. While **Engaging** with the child during home visits and supporting educational advocacy. The CASA volunteer **Recommends** the best interests on behalf of the child, while focusing on the **FACTS** gathered. They **Collaborate** with others to ensure the child is provided resources while in foster care. Then **Reports** observations to the Children's Court Judge.

**TRAINING
REQUIREMENTS**

Our CASA volunteers must be 21 years or older. Complete a 25- hour. pre-service training or our independent guided learning track along with 5 hours of court observations.

**TIME
COMMITMENT**

Our CASA volunteers meet with their CASA child once a month and attend any meetings or court hearings that pertain to the case. This looks like 6-10 hours per month.

**ONE YEAR
COMMITMENT**

It is our goal to have volunteers stay on the CASA case until their CASA child reaches a safe and permanent home.
